*To go to school, no matter where they live or how long they have lived there.*

They must be given access to the same public education, including preschool education provided to other children.

*To stay in their original or last school even if they move to another district.*

Homeless students have the right to stay in the school they attended prior to the loss of housing, or to remain in the school they were last enrolled, unless the parent or unaccompanied youth chooses otherwise. This is called the "school of origin".

School districts must arrange transportation for students in homeless situations so that students can stay at their school of origin, even if students move to a different city, county or school district.
